## ORDINANCE NO. 1669

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, ABANDONING A PORTION OF OLD SAM HOUSTON ROAD ADJACENT TO THE WEST PROPERTY LINE OF 4918 SAMUELL BOULEVARD, APPROXIMATELY 1,230 FEET WEST OF BIG TOWN BOULEVARD, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A QUITCLAIM DEED TO THE ADJOINING PROPERTY OWNER; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS.

SECTION 1. That the portion of Old Sam Houston Road adjacent to the west property line of 4918 Samuell Boulevard, approximately 1,230 Lest west of Big Town Boulevard, City of Mesquite, Dallas County, Texas, and described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto, shall be, and the same is hereby abandoned.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor of the City of Mesquite, Texas, is hereby authorized to execute a Quitclaim deed to the adjoining property owner.

SECTION 3. That the orderly development of the City of Mesquite requires that the portion of old Sam Houston Road as described in Exhibit "A" be abandoned creates an urgency and an emergency in the public interest and necessitates that this ordinance become effective immediately from and after its date of passage and the publication of the caption as the law in such cases provides.
