

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, TO PROVIDE FOR A CHANGE OF NAME FOR A CERTAIN STREET WITHIN THE CITY; THE LOCATION OF SAID STREET DESCRIBED AS PORTIONS OF BLOCK 10, LOTS 6 THROUGH 23, AND PORTIONS OF BLOCK 14, LOTS 1 THROUGH 14 OF THE COUNTRY MEADOWS ADDITION NO. 2, VOLUME 80139, PAGE 0990, DALLAS COUNTY DEED RECORDS, DALLAS COUNTY, TEXAS, RECORDED ON JULY 15, 1980.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. That the street formerly named Erath Drive, the location of said street described as portions of Block 10, Lots 6 through 23, and portions of Block 14, Lots 1 through 14 of the Country Meadows Addition No. 2, Volume 80139, page 0990 Dallas County Deed Records, Dallas County, Texas, recorded on July 15, 1980, be and is hereby renamed Robert Jones Drive.

SECTION 2. That the provisions of this ordinance shall be effective on June 15, 1981.


SECTION 3. That should any word, sentence, clause, paragraph or provision of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. The fact that the ordinances of the City of Mesquite, Texas, do not adequately provide for the orderly identification of newly constructed streets creates an urgency and emergency and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication as the law in such cases provides.
