AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS GRANTING PERMISSION TO TRANSFER THE MESQUITE CABLE TELEVISION FRANCHISE FROM WARNER AMEX CABLE COMMUNICATIONS, INC. TO WARNER AMEX CABLE COMMUNICATIONS COMPANY OF MESQUITE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Article II, Section 10 of the Franchise Agreement provides for transfer of the Mesquite Cable Television Franchise upon permission of the City of Mesquite; and,

WHEREAS, Warner Amex Cable Communications, Inc. has made application to transfer said Franchise to Warner Amex Cable Communications Company of Mesquite, agreeing to be responsible for all obligations assumed in the original agreement; and,

WHEREAS, on May 18, 1981 the City Council, by oral motion agreed to such transfer;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

That permission is hereby granted to transfer the Mesquite Cable Television Franchise from Warner Amex Cable Communications, Inc. to Warner Amex Cable Communications Company of Mesquite with the understanding that Warner Amex Cable Communications, Inc. will guarantee performance of all obligations assumed in the original Franchise instrument.

SECTION 2. The fact that the present ordinances of the City are inadequate to clearly establish the parties responsible for providing Cable Television service in the City creates an urgency and an emergency for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication of said ordinance, as the law in such cases provides.
