## ORDINANCE NO. 1702

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER X OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE BY ADDING SECTION 10-61.7 TO PROHIBIT PARKING ON THE NORTH SERVICE ROAD OF US 80, BOTH SIDES FROM INTERSTATE BLVD. WESTWARD TO A POINT 100 FEET EAST OF THE EASTERMOST TEJAS DRIVEWAY BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 7:00 P.M. TO 6:00 A.M.; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED (\$200.00) DOLLARS FOR EACH OFFENSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 10 of the Code of the City of Mesquite is hereby amended by adding Section 10-61.7, in all other respects said section and code to remain in full force and effect:

When notice is given by the erection of signs or the marking of curbs to such effect, it shall be unlawful to park or stand a vehicle on the following streets or portions thereof during the designated times:

STREET	EXTENT	TIME
North Service Road of US 80	Both Sides from Interstate Blvd. westward to a point 100 feet east of the easter- most Tejas driveway	7:00 P.M. to 6:00 A.M.

SECTION 2. That any person violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor and upon conviction in the Municipal Court shall be subject to a fine not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense.

SECTION 3. That should any paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase, or section of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part so decided to be invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. The fact that the Code of the City of Mesquite, Texas is inadequate to control the orderly flow of traffic on the North Service Road of US 80 creates an urgency and an emergency for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication of said ordinance, as the law in such cases provides.
