OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS

THE CITY OF MESQUITE, in Dallas County, Texas, hereby gives notice of intention to issue CITY OF MESQUITE, CERTIFICATES OF OBLIGATION, SERIES 1981, in the maximum principal amount of \$1,450,000 , for the purpose of paying for the purchase of land and improvements needed for a municipal airport, to-wit: a tract aggregating 127.781 acres out of the McKinney and Williams Survey, Abstract No. 1026, and the W.S. Robinson Survey, Abstract No. 1262, City of Mesquite, Dallas County, Texas, generally known as the Hudson Airport, and paying all or a portion of the contractual obligations for professional services of attorneys, appraisers, and financial advisors in connection with such land and Certificates of Obligation. The City proposes to provide for the payment of such Certificates of Obligation from the levy and collection of ad valorem taxes in the City as provided by law. The City Council of the City tentatively proposes to authorize the issuance of such Certificates of Obligation at 3:00 p.m. on December 15, 1981, at the Municipal Building, Mesquite, Texas.
