ORDINANCE NO. 1742

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, ADOPTING A REVISED EMPLOYEES' SALARY AND PAY PLAN CLASSIFICATION BY DELETING FOUR (4) COMMUNICATIONS OPERATOR POSITIONS AND CREATING FOUR (4) LEAD COMMUNICATIONS OPERA-TOR POSITIONS; BY PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the revised Employees' Salary and Classification Plan be amended as follows:

The number of positions as Communications Operator authorized in the 1981-82 budget is hereby reduced from sixteen (16) to twelve (12).

SECTION 2. There is hereby created the classification of Lead Communications Operator as per the attached job description and four (4) positions are hereby authorized with a pay grade eleven (11) with a salary range of \$1174 - \$1568.

That should any word, sentence, clause, paragraph or provision of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. The fact that the present Employees Classification and Salary Plan of the City of Mesquite is inadequate to provide stability and continuity in the employment of essential employees creates an urgency and an emergency and necessitates that this ordinance become effective immediately from and after its date of passage and the publication of its caption as the law in such cases provides.
