ORDINANCE NO. 1751

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING SECTION 5B-6 OF THE CITY CODE TO PROVIDE FOR THE MANNER OF DISPLAYING THE LICENSE FOR COIN-OPERATED AMUSE-MENT MACHINES; BY PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; BY PROVIDING A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) FOR EACH OFFENSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Section 5B-6 of the City Code is hereby amended as follows, in all other respects to remain in full force and effect:

A new paragraph (c) is hereby added.

(c) Evidence of payment of the ten dollar (\$10.00) fee for individual machines shall consist of a sticker to be provided by the City and permanently affixed to the machine in such a manner that it can be seen from the usual position of the player and facing such position and shall be displayed at all times such machine is displayed.

SECTION 2. Should any word, phrase, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional the remaining provisions of this crdinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed to be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction in the Municipal Court shall be subject to a fine not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense.

SECTION 4. The fact that the Code of the City of Mesquite does not adequately provide for the manner of displaying the license for coin-operated amusement machines creates an urgency and an emergency and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from its passage and publication as the law in such cases provides.
