

## ORDINANCE NO. 1781

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS,  
EXTENDING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE TEXAS  
POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY PROPOSED FUEL COST  
FACTOR TARIFF FOR AN ADDITIONAL THIRTY (30)  
DAYS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Texas Power and Light Company filed a proposed  
fuel cost factor tariff on December 9, 1982

WHEREAS, the effective date of such increase was extended  
for 120 days; and

WHEREAS, additional time is required by the city to investigate  
and determine the need for a rate increase;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the effective date of the proposed Texas  
Power and Light Company proposed fuel cost factor tariff is  
extended for an additional thirty (30) days from May 12, 1982.


SECTION 2. The fact that the City Council requires additional  
time to consider the above fuel cost factor tariff request creates  
an urgency and an emergency for the preservation of the public  
health, safety, and welfare and requires that this ordinance shall  
take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication  
of said ordinance, as the law in such cases provides.
