

ORDINANCE NO. 1912

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, CHANGING THE NAME OF INTERSTATE BOULEVARD TO EAST MEADOWS BOULEVARD AND MAKING ALL LAWS AND REGULATIONS HERETOFORE APPLICABLE TO INTERSTATE BOULEVARD APPLICABLE TO EAST MEADOWS BOULEVARD; BY PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; BY PROVIDING A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) FOR EACH OFFENSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the street heretofore designated Interstate Boulevard in the City of Mesquite is hereby renamed to East Meadows Boulevard and all laws and regulations heretofore pertaining to Interstate Boulevard shall hereafter be applicable to East Meadows Boulevard.

SECTION 2. That should any word, phrase, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed to be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction in the Municipal Court shall be subject to a fine not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense.



The fact that the ordinances of the City of Mesquite are inadequate to properly authorize and designate traffic control devices in the City creates an urgency and emergency for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from its passage and publication as the law in such cases provides.
