## ORDINANCE NO. 1965

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, REDUCING THE NUMBER OF POSITIONS OF THE CLASSIFICATION OF FIRE LIEUTENANT FROM SIX-TEEN (16) TO FIFTEEN (15) AND ABOLISHING THE POSITION OF POLICE RECORDS SUPERVISOR; BY PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND DECLAR-ING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Council heretofore duly enacted by Ordinance sixteen (16) positions of Fire Lieutenant and one (1) position of Records Supervisor; and

WHEREAS, it is contemplated that such positions are unnecessary at this time.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the number of positions in the classification of Fire Lieutenant heretofore are reduced from sixteen (16) to fifteen (15) and the position of Police Records Supervisor is hereby abolished.

SECTION 2. That should any word, sentence, clause, paragraph, or provision of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. The fact that the ordinances of the City of Mesquite are inadequate for the efficient operation of the Fire and Police Departments creates an urgency and an emergency and necessitates that this ordinance become effective immediately from and after its date of passage and the publication of its caption as the law in such cases provides.
