AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, ADOPTING A REVISED EMPLOYEES' SALARY AND PAY PLAN CLASSIFICATION BY ADDING THE CLASSIFICATION OF POLICE RECORDS SUPERVISOR POSITION; BY PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the revised Employees' Salary and Classification Plan be amended as follows:

There is hereby added the classification of Police Records Supervisor with a pay grade 14 and a beginning salary of \$1497.00 and one position in such classification is authorized.

SECTION 2. That should any word, sentence, clause, paragraph or provision of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. The fact that the present Employees Classification and Salary Plan of the City of Mesquite is inadequate to provide for the prudent employment of employees creates an urgency and an emergency and necessitates that this ordinance become effective immediately from and after its date of passage and the publication of its caption as the law in such cases provides.
