ORDINANCE NO. 2005

DIRECTING PUBLICATION OF NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ISSUE CERTIFICATES OF OBLIGATION

THE STATE OF TEXAS COUNTY OF DALLAS CITY OF MESQUITE

WHEREAS, the City deems it advisable to give notice of intention to issue certificates of obligation in the amount of \$900,000, for the purpose of paying, in whole or in part, contractual obligations for acquiring 4.797 acres adjacent to the City Hall, and to pay all or a portion of the legal, fiscal and closing fees in connection with this project; and

WHEREAS, it is hereby officially found and determined that a case of emergency or urgent public necessity exists which requires the holding of the meeting at which this Ordinance is passed as an emergency measure, such emergency or urgent public necessity being that the notice of intention to issue certificates of obligation should be published as soon as possible and without delay for necessary and urgently needed public improvements; and that said meeting was open to the public and public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given, all as required by Art. 6252-17, V.A.T.C.S.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE:

- That attached hereto is a form of the Notice of Intention to issue Certificates of Obligation, the form and substance of which is hereby adopted and approved.
- That the City Secretary shall cause said notice to be published in substantially the form attached hereto, in a newspaper of general circulation in said City, and published in said City, on the same day in each of two consecutive weeks, the date of the first publication thereof to be at least 14 days prior to the time set for the issuance of such certificates of obligation as shown in said notice.
