

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS,  
SUSPENDING THE OPERATION OF THE PROPOSED TARIFF  
FILED BY TEXAS POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY FOR A  
PERIOD OF NINETY (90) DAYS BEYOND THE DATE ON  
WHICH SUCH TARIFF SCHEDULE WOULD OTHERWISE GO  
INTO EFFECT; AND PROVIDING FOR NOTICE HEREOF  
TO SAID PUBLIC UTILITY.

WHEREAS, Texas Power & Light Company did, on March 9, 1984,  
filed a proposed tariff for service within the City of Mesquite  
to become effective April 13, 1984; and

WHEREAS, after having considered the presentation of Texas  
Power & Light Company, it is the opinion of the City Council of  
the City of Mesquite that such proposed tariff should be suspended  
for a period of 90 days from April 13, 1984, for further study,  
investigation, presentation of evidence and public hearing; and

WHEREAS, a copy of this ordinance has been provided to Texas  
Power & Light Company.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Section 43(d) of the Public Utility  
Regulatory Act, the operation of the proposed tariff filed with  
the City of Mesquite on March 9, 1984, by Texas Power & Light  
Company, is hereby suspended for a period of 90 days from April  
13, 1984, for further study, investigation, presentation of  
evidence and public hearing.
