ORDINANCE NO. 2023

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, SUSPENDING THE OPERATION OF THE PROPOSED RATE INCREASE FILED BY LONE STAR GAS COMPANY FOR A PERIOD OF NINETY (90) DAYS BEYOND THE DATE ON WHICH SUCH RATE SCHEDULE WOULD OTHERWISE GO INTO EFFECT; AND PROVIDING FOR NOTICE HEREOF TO SAID PUBLIC UTILITY.

WHEREAS, Lone Star Gas Company did, on April 17, 1984, file a proposed rate for gas service within the City of Mesquite to become effective May 23, 1984; and

WHEREAS, after having considered the presentation of Lone Star Gas Company, it is the opinion of the City Council of the City of Mesquite that such proposed rate schedule should be suspended for a period of 90 days from May 23, 1984, for further study, investigation, presentation of evidence and public hearing; and

WHEREAS, notice of this ordinance has been provided to Lone Star Gas Company.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Section 43(d) of the Public Utility Regulatory Act, the operation of the proposed rate increase filed with the City of Mesquite on April 17, 1984, by Lone Star Gas Company, is hereby suspended for a period of 90 days from May 23, 1984, for further study, investigation, presentation of evidence and public hearing.
