## ORDINANCE NO. 2057

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER X, SECTION 10-47.5 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE BY DELETING CERTAIN PRESENT LANGUAGE THEREBY REMOVING CERTAIN SCHOOL SPEED ZONES FOR HANBY ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, AND AMENDING CHAPTER X, SECTION 10-34.1 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE BY REQUIRING MANDATORY RIGHT TURNS AT CERTAIN LOCATIONS ALONG GALLOWAY AVENUE, AND AMENDING CHAPTER X, SECTION 10-61.2 BY PROHIBITING PARKING ON PORTIONS OF TOWNE CROSSING BOULEVARD AND DRIFTWOOD DRIVE; BY PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; BY PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED (\$200.00) DOLLARS FOR EACH OFFENSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Chapter X, Section 10-47.5 of the Code of the City of Mesquite is hereby amended as follows, in all other respects to remain in full force and effect:

The following language shall be deleted from Chapter X, Section 10-47.5 of the Code of the City of Mesquite:

SCHOOL

LOCATION OF SCHOOL ZONE

Hanby

Kearney Street from Gross Road to Matador Lane

Scyene Road from a point 150 feet east of its intersection with Gross Road to its intersection with Gross Road

SECTION 2. That Chapter X, Section 10-34.1 of the Code of the City of Mesquite is amended as follows, in all other respects to remain in full force and effect:

The following language shall be added to Chapter X, Section 10-34.1 of the Code of the City of Mesquite, which requires mandatory right turns:

- (15) Northbound Galloway Avenue at Tripp Road
- (16) Southbound Galloway Avenue at Tripp Road

COOS SECTION 3. That Chapter A, becomes the City of Mesquite shall be amended as follows, in all other. SECTION 3. That Chapter X, Section 10-61.2 of the Code of respects to remain in full force and effect:

> The following language shall be added to Chapter X, Section 10-61.2 of the Code of the City of Mesquite, Texas which prohibits parking at any time on certain designated streets:

Towne Crossing Boulevard, both sides, from I. H. 30 Service Road to Town East Boulevard.

Driftwood Drive, both sides, from Gus Thomasson Road to Towne Crossing Boulevard.

SECTION 4. That should any word, sentence, clause, paragraph or provision of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5. That any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction in the Municipal Court shall be punished by a fine not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense.

SECTION 6. The fact that the present ordinances of the City of Mesquite do not adequately protect the safety of the inhabitan of the City creates an urgency and an emergency for the preservat of the public health, safety, and welfare and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication of said ordinance, as the law in such cases provides.
