AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1803 BY INCREASING THE CHARGES FOR CUTTING OF VEGETATION AND REMOVAL OF OBSTRUCTIONS AND PROVIDING FOR A LIEN ON REAL PROPERTY; BY PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; BY PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) FOR EACH OFFENSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 1803 of the City of Mesquite duly passed on the 16th day of August, 1982, is hereby amended as follows, in all other respects to remain in full force and effect:

(a)	All lots up to 12,000 square feet	\$ <u>5</u> 0.00
	All lots 12,000 square feet to one acre	60.00
	Each additional acre or part thereof	35.00

SECTION 2. Should any word, phrase, sentence, paragraph, or section of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitution the remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in full for and effect.

SECTION 3. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed to be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction in the Corporation Court shall be subject to a fine not to exceed Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars for each offense.
