AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS AMENDING CHAPTER 2B OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE BY ADOPTION OF THE 1982 EDITION OF THE UNIFORM MECHANICAL CODE WITH CERTAIN AMENDMENTS AND DELETIONS; BY PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; BY PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) FOR EACH OFFENSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 2B of the Code of the City of Mesquite is hereby amended as follows, in all other respects to remain in full force and effect:
- A. Section 2B-1, is hereby amended by changing the year, "1976" Edition to "1982" Edition.
- B. Section 14A-2B-1.1 is deleted in its entirety and a new Section 2B-1.1 is added to read as follows:

DELETIONS

Section 2203 (P. 260 App. B) is deleted in its entirety

AMENDMENTS

Section 304, Permit fees (pp. 7-9) is amended to read, "Section 304, Permit fees and Table 3A (pp. 22-23)"

- SECTION 2. That should any word, sentence, clause, paragraph or provision of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
- SECTION 3. That any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be deemed to be guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor and subject to the same penalty as provided for in the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of 1973, of the City of Mesquite, and upon conviction in the Municipal Court shall be punished by a fine not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense.
- SECTION 4. The fact that the present ordinances of the City of Mesquite are inadequate to protect the health and welfare the inhabitants of the City of Mesquite creates an urgency and an emergency and necessitates that this ordinance become effective immediately from and after its date of passage and the publication of its caption as the law in such cases provides.
