ORDINANCE NO. 2100

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER X, SECTION 10-47.8 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE BY DELETING CERTAIN PRESENT LANGUAGE AND ADDING CERTAIN LANGUAGE THEREBY CLARIFYING CERTAIN SPEED ZONE LOCATIONS, AND AMENDING CHAPTER X, SECTION 10-47.5 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE BY DELETING CERTAIN PRESENT LANGUAGE AND ADDING CERTAIN LANGUAGE, THEREBY, CHANGING THE DESIGNATION FOR THE SCHOOL ZONE ON NORTH GALLOWAY AVENUE FOR TISINGER ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, BY PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; BY PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED (\$200.00) DOLLARS FOR EACH OFFENSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Chapter X, Section 10-47.8 of the Code of the City of Mesquite is hereby amended as follows, in all other respects to remain in full force and effect:

The following language shall be deleted from Chapter X, Section 10-47.5 of the Code of the City of Mesquite:

STREET

EXTENT

SPEED (MPH)

East Main Street

The following language shall be added to Chapter X, Section 10-47.8 of the Code of the City of Mesquite:

STREET

EXTENT

SPEED (MPH)

Main Street

From Pioneer Road to Phillip Street........... 40

SECTION 2. Chapter X, Section 10-47.5 of the Code of the City of Hesquite is hereby amended as follows, in all other respects to remain in full force and effect:

The following language shall be deleted from Chapter X, Section 10-47.5 of the Code of the City of Mesquite:

SCHOOL

LOCATION OF SCHOOL ZONE

Tisinger

North Galloway northbound from 55 feet of north curb of Hillcrest to 16 feet north of north curb of Hillview

The following language shall be added to Chapter X, Section 10-47.5 of the Code of the City of Mesquite:

SCHOOL

LOCATION OF SCHOOL ZONE

Tisinger

North Galloway 50 feet north of Longview Street to 100 feet south of the south curb line of Highland Street

SECTION 3. That should any word, sentence, clause, paragraph or provision of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. That any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction in the Municipal Court shall be punished by a fine not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense.

SECTION 5. The Fact that the present ordinances of the City of Mesquite do not adequately protect the safety of the inhabitants of the City creates an urgency and an emergency for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication of said ordinance, as the law in such cases provides.
