ORDINANCE NO. 2120

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING THE CITY OF MESQUITE CLASSIFICATION AND PAY PLAN BY ABOLISHING FOUR (4) FIRE LIEUTENANT POSITIONS AND CREATING FIVE (5) NEW FIRE CAPTAIN POSITIONS AND NINE (9) NEW DRIVER-ENGINEER POSITIONS; BY PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMER-GENCY:

NOW. THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE. TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City of Mesquite Classification and Pay Plan is hereby amended as follows, in all other respects to remain in full force and effect:

- A. The number of Fire Lieutenant positions heretofore authorized is hereby reduced by four (4) and the said four (4) positions are hereby abolished:
- B. The number of Fire Captain positions heretofore authorized is hereby increased by five (5) and said five (5) positions are hereby created;
- The number of Driver-Engineer positions heretofore authorized is hereby increased by nine (9) and said nine (9) positions are hereby created.
- SECTION 2. That should any word, sentence, clause, paragraph or provision of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
- SECTION 3. The fact that the present number of Fire personnel of the City of Mesquite are inadequate to protect the health and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Mesquite creates an urgency and an emergency and necessitates that this ordinance become effective immediately from and after its date of passage and the publication of its caption as the law in such cases provides.
