ORDINANCE NO. 2127

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, CHANGING THE NAMES OF PORTIONS OF CERTAIN STREETS IN SOUTHEAST MESQUITE, TO BE EFFECTIVE UPON COMPLETION OF CERTAIN STREET EXTENSIONS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY:


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The names of certain streets in Southeast Mesquite shall be changed as follows:

- The street heretofore named Mathis Road, from Edwards Road to Lawson Road, is hereby named Clay Road, such change effective upon the completion of Clay Road extension between Newsom Road and Lawson Road;
- 2. That portion of Mesquite Valley Road from Berry Road to approximately 1700 feet southwest is hereby named Mercury Road, such changes effective upon the completion of the Mercury Road Extension from Cartwright Road to this portion of Mesquite Valley Road;
- 3. That portion of Mesquite Valley Road from the proposed Mercury Road extension to approximately 2100 feet northwest is hereby named Creek Valley, such change effective upon the completion of the portion of Creek Valley extending from Newsom Road to this portion of Mesquite Valley Road;
- 4. That portion of Mesquite Valley Road from proposed Creek Valley to proposed Clay Road is hereby named Creek Crossing, such change effective upon completion of the section of Creek Crossing extending from Berry Road to this portion of Mesquite Valley Road.

SECTION 2. The fact that lead time is needed prior to the effective date of the street name changes creates an urgency and emergency and necessitates that this ordinance become effective immediately from and after its date of passage and the publication of its caption as the law in such cases provides.
