AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS AMENDING SECTION 10-33.12 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS BY ESTABLISHING CERTAIN NO U-TURN LOCATIONS, BY ESTABLISH-ING AND AUTHORIZING CERTAIN TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVISES AS OFFICIAL TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE; BY PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; BY PROVIDING A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) FOR EACH OFFENSE; AND DECLARING AN EMER-GENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Section 10-33.12 of the Code of the City of Mesquite is hereby amended as follows, in all other respects to remain in full force and effect:

It is hereby expressly provided that the traffic control devices at the following locations are official traffic control devices of the City of Mesquite and the same are hereby authorized as such and shall be deemed to have been officially placed thereat under authority of the governing body of the City of Mesquite:

1. To the list of No U-Turn signs in Section 10-33.12 the following are added:

Town East Boulevard at Tradewind Drive, Northbound.

Town East Boulevard 220 feet south of Tradewind Drive, Northbound.

SECTION 2. That all ordinances, or portions thereof, of the City of Mesquite in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, to the extent of such conflict are hereby repealed. To the extent that such ordinances or portions thereof not in conflict herewith, the same shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That should any paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause phrase, section or provision of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part so decided to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid and shall not affect the validity of the remainder of Article 10-47.8, or any other provision of the Code of the City of Mesquite. SECTION 4. That any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be deemed to be guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor and subject to the same penalty as provided for in the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of 1973, of the City of Mesquite, and upon conviction in the Municipal Court shall be punished by a fine not to exceed Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars for each offense.

<u>SECTION 5.</u> The fact that the ordinances of the City of Mesquite are inadequate to properly authorize and designate no U-Turn sign traffic control devices in the City creates an urgency and emergency for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from its passage and publication as the law in such cases provides.
