

ORDINANCE NO. 2184

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS AMENDING CHAPTER 10 SECTION 10-47.8 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE BY DELETING CERTAIN PRESENT LANGUAGE AND ADDING CERTAIN LANGUAGE THEREBY DESIGNATING SPEED LIMITS FOR PORTIONS OF GUS THOMASSON ROAD; BY PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; BY PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED (\$200.00) DOLLARS FOR EACH OFFENSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 10, Section 10-47.8 of the Code of the City of Mesquite is hereby amended as follows, in all other respects to remain in full force and effect:

The following language shall be deleted from Chapter 10, Section 10-47.8 of the Code of the City of Mesquite:

STREET	EXTENT	SPEED (MPH)
Gus Thomasson Road	From U.S. Highway 80 Service Road north to the north City Limit Line	35

The following language shall be added to Chapter 10, Section 10-47.8 of the Code of the City of Mesquite:

STREET	EXTENT	SPEED (MPH)
Gus Thomasson Road	From U.S. Highway 80 Service Road to 300 feet north of Motley Drive	35
Gus Thomasson Road	From 300 feet north of Motley Drive to 300 feet south of North Mesquite Drive	45
Gus Thomasson Road	From 300 feet south of North Mesquite Drive to north city limit	35

SECTION 2. That all ordinances of the City of Mesquite in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be, and the same are, hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict and ordinances not in conflict herewith shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That should any paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase, section or provision of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part so decided to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid and shall not affect the validity of the remainder of Article 10-47.8, or any other provision of the Code of the City of Mesquite.

SECTION 4. That any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be deemed to be guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor and subject to the same penalty as provided for in the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of 1973, of the City of Mesquite, and upon conviction in the Municipal Court shall be punished by a fine not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense.

SECTION 5. The fact that the present ordinances of the City of Mesquite do not adequately regulate the rate of speed of vehicles on Gus Thomasson Road creates an urgency and emergency and in the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, requires that this ordinance shall become effective immediately from and after its passage and the publication of said ordinance, as the law and charter in such cases provides.
