ORDINANCE NO. 2208

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, ESTABLISHING A TWENTY-EIGHT (28) DAY WORK PERIOD FOR MEMBERS OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on July 1, 1985, the City Council of the City of Mesquite established by motion a work period of twenty-eight (28) days for members of the Police Department;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That for the purposes of establishing overtime pay for members of the Police Department pursuant to 29 U.S.C. 207(K) and 29 C.F.R. 553 there is hereby established a work period of twenty-eight (28) days, the first period beginning on July 1, 1985 and a subsequent period beginning each twenty-eight (28) days thereafter.

SECTION 2. That the requirement of the Federal Fair Labor Standards Act that this work period be established creates an urgency and an emergency and necessitates that this Ordinance become effective immediately from and after its date of passage and the publication of its caption as the law in such cases provides.
