

ORDINANCE NO. 2223

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS,
DETERMINING THE POPULATION OF THE CITY AS OF
OCTOBER 1, 1985 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, by Charter Amendment, the City Council is required to
determine the population as of the beginning of the fiscal year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the official population of the City as of October
1, 1985 is hereby determined to be 89,950.

SECTION 2. The fact that no regular scheduled Council meeting
will take place prior to October 1, 1985 and the City Charter requires
the population to be determined as of that date creates an urgency and
emergency and requires this ordinance take effect immediately as the
law in such cases provides.
