## ORDINANCE NO. 2252

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS AMENDING CHAPTER X, SECTION 10-47.8 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE BY DELETING CERTAIN PRESENT LANGUAGE AND ADDING CERTAIN LANGUAGE THEREBY CHANGING CERTAIN SPEED ZONE LOCATIONS ON THE SOUTH AND NORTH SERVICE ROAD OF U.S. HIGHWAY 80; BY PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; BY PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED (\$200.00) DOLLARS FOR EACH OFFENSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Chapter X, Section 10-47.8 of the Code of the City of Mesquite is hereby amended as follows, in all other respects to remain in full force and effect:

The following language shall be deleted from Chapter X, Section 10-47.8 of the Code of the City of Mesquite:

STREET	EXTENT	SPEED (MPH)
U.S. Highway 80	South Service Road, from west city limits to east city limits	40
U.S. Highway 80	North Service Road, from West city limits to east city limits	40
U.S. Highway 80	One-half mile on either side of Galloway Avenue, during the State construction project	40

The following language shall be added to Chapter X, Section 10-47.8 of the Code of the City of Mesquite:

STREET	EXTENT	SPEED (MPH)
U.S. Highway 80	South Service Road, from west city limits to east city limits	45
U.S. Highway 80	North Service Road, from west city limits to east city limits	45

SECTION 2. That should any paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause phrase, section or provision of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part so decided to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid and shall not affect the validity of the

remainder of Article 10-47.8, or any other provision of the Code of the City of Mesquite.

SECTION 3. That any person, firm, or corporation violating any the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be deemed to be guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor and upon conviction in the Municipal Court shall be punished by a fine not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense.

SECTION 4. The fact that the present ordinances of the City of Mesquite do not adequately protect the safety of the inhabitants of the City creates an urgency and emergency and in the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare requires that this ordinances shall become effective immediately from and after its passage and the publication of caption, as the law and in such cases provides.
