

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING THE 1985-86 FISCAL BUDGET BY APPROPRIATING CERTAIN FUNDS FOR CERTAIN ACCOUNTS AND REDUCING THE APPROPRIATE FUND BALANCES ACCORDINGLY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to employ two additional meter readers to effect collection of water and sewer accounts; and

WHEREAS, unless the two additional meter readers are employed the City will suffer substantial loss of revenue creating a grave public necessity; and

WHEREAS, such expenditures are necessary to meet unusual and unforeseen emergency conditions which could not, by reasonable diligent thought and attention, have been included in the original budget;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the 1985-86 fiscal budget adopted by the City Council on September 16, 1985 is hereby amended as follows; in all other respects to remain in full force and effect:

The following sums for the items shown are hereby appropriated and the funds therefore are hereby transferred from the appropriate fund balances of which were increased by such amounts not being paid during the 1985-86 fiscal year to the account numbers indicated below:

SECTION 2. The fact that the sums shown above have become necessary in the 1985-86 fiscal year without provision for payment creates a grave public necessity to amend the City's budget and creates an urgency and an emergency for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and requires that this ordinance

shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication of said ordinance, as the law in such cases provides.
