ORDINANCE NO. 2287

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS ADOPTING DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME FOR THE TWENTY-FOUR (24) HOUR PERIOD BEGINNING AT 11:00 P.M. O'CLOCK ON APRIL 11, 1986, FOR THE PURPOSE OF DETERMINING THE DATE OF THE RUN-OFF ELECTION FOR COUNCIL PLACES FOUR (4) AND FIVE (5) AND DECLARING AN EMER-GENCY.

WHEREAS the City Council of the City of Mesquite is empowered to establish its fiscal year and its work days and the hours thereof and to preserve and enforce good government;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That for the purpose of determining the date of the run-off election for City Council places four (4) and five (5) and for no other purpose it is hereby declared and established that Daylight Saving Time shall begin within the City limits at 11:00 P.M. o'clock on Friday, April 11, 1986, and shall continue for twenty-four (24) hours thereafter, at which time it shall revert back to Central Standard Time and all acts of the City Council that determine the date of said run-off election performed after 11:00 P.M. o'clock, April 11, 1986, and during the subsequent twenty-four (24) hours shall, for that purpose only, be deemed to have occurred on Saturday, April 12, 1986.

SECTION 2. The fact that a Run-Off Election date must be established immediately in order to fill certain City Council positions creates an urgency and an emergency and necessitates that this ordinance become effective immediately from and after its date of passage and the publication of its caption as the law in such cases provides.
