ORDINANCE No. 2298

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, ANNEXING CERTAIN LAND AS DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A", AND ATTACHED HERETO AND MADE A PART OF THIS ORDINANCE, LOCATED GENERALLY SOUTH AND EAST OF THE PRESENT CITY LIMITS AND NEAR INTERSTATE HIGHWAY 20 AND THE TRINITY RIVER, EXTEND-ING THE BOUNDARY LIMITS OF SAID CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, DALLAS COUNTY, TEXAS, AND GRANTING TO ALL THE INHABITANTS AND OWNERS OF THE PROPERTY THE RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES OF ALL OTHER CITI-ZENS AND BINDING ALL INHABITANTS BY ALL THE ACTS, ORDINANCES AND REGULATIONS OF SAID CITY; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION OF SAID ORDINANCE; AND PROVIDING FOR THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF SAID ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite has heretofore adopted a Home Rule Charter authorizing it to annex territory and extend the corporate limits of said City; and

WHEREAS, the property described in Exhibit "A" as attached hereto and made a part of this ordinance, is adjoining the present City limits of the City of Mesquite and the City Council of the City of Mesquite has concluded that said area should be annexed and made a part of the City of Mesquite, Texas; and

WHEREAS, all of said land is within the extra-territorial jurisdiction of the City of Mesquite, Texas; and

WHEREAS, the owners of said land has lawfully petitioned the City for annexation; and

WHEREAS, two (2) public hearings as provided by law have been held by the City Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the property described in Exhibit "A" as attached hereto and made a part of this ordinance, be, and the same is, hereby annexed to the City of Mesquite, Dallas County, Texas, and the boundary limits of the City of Mesquite be, and the same are, hereby extended to include the territory described in Exhibit "A" within the City Pimits of the City of Mesquite, and the same shall hereafter be included within the territorial limits of said City, and the inhabitants thereof shall hereafter be entitled to all rights and privileges of other citizens of the City of Mesquite and shall be bound by the acts, ordinances, resolutions and regulations of said City.

SECTION 2. That should any protion of the territory as described in Exhibit "A" not be subject to legal annexation by the City of Mesquite, such fact shall not prevent the City from annexing such territory which is subject to legal annexation by the City, and it is the intention of the City of Mesquite to annex only such territory as may be legally annexed by it within the limits of the area described in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage as the Charter in such cases provides.


