

ORDINANCE No. 2333

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER X, SECTION 10-33.12(2) OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS BY ADDING CERTAIN LANGUAGE THEREBY PROHIBITING U-TURNS AT CERTAIN LOCATIONS AND AMENDING CHAPTER X, SECTION 10-47.5 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE BY ADDING CERTAIN LANGUAGE THEREBY ESTABLISHING A SCHOOL ZONE; BY PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; BY PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED (\$200.00) DOLLARS FOR EACH OFFENSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Chapter X, Section 10-33.12(2) of the City of Mesquite, Texas is hereby amended as follows, in all other respects to remain in full force and effect:

The following language shall be added to Chapter X, Section 10-33.12(2) of the Code of the City of Mesquite which prohibits U-turns:

Big Town Boulevard, Southbound, at Paces Court

Town East Boulevard, Northeast bound 250 feet Southwest of Tradewind

SECTION 2. Chapter X, Section 10-47.5 of the Code of the City of Mesquite, Texas is hereby amended as follows, in all other respects to remain in full force and effect:

The following language shall be added to Chapter X, Section 10-47.5 of the Code of the City of Mesquite which designates school zones:

SCHOOL

LOCATION OF SCHOOL ZONE

Price Elementary

Northwest Drive from 400 feet south of Meadowglen Lane to 400 feet north of Meadowglen Lane

SECTION 3. That should any paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause phrase, section or provision of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part so decided to be unconstitu-

tional, illegal, or invalid and shall not affect the validity of the remainder of Article 10-47.8, or any other provision of the Code of the City of Mesquite.

SECTION 4. That any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be deemed to be guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor and subject to the same penalty as provided for in the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of 1973, of the City of Mesquite, and upon conviction in the Municipal Court shall be punished by a fine not to exceed Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars for each offense.

SECTION 5. The fact that the present ordinances of the City of Mesquite are inadequate to protect the safety of the inhabitants of the City of Mesquite creates an urgency and an emergency and necessitates that this ordinance become effective immediately from and after its date of passage and the publication of its caption as the law in such cases provides.
