

## ORDINANCE NO. 2407

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS AMENDING CHAPTER 13 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS BY ADDING A NEW SECTION 13-21 PROHIBITING THE PARKING AND STORING OF BOATS AND BOAT TRAILERS UPON PUBLIC STREETS WITHIN THE CITY; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED (\$200.00) DOLLARS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 13 of the Code of the City of Mesquite is hereby amended by adding a new Section 13-21 to read as follows, in all other respects to remain in full force an effect:

SECTION 13-21. Parking of boats and boat trailers on public streets prohibited.

It shall be unlawful and an offense for any person to park store or leave standing a boat or boat trailer upon a public street or permit a boat or boat trailer under their control to be parked, stored or left standing upon a public street.

SECTION 2. That any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be deemed to be guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor and upon conviction in the Municipal Court shall be punished by a fine not to exceed Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars for each offense.


SECTION 3. The fact that the Code of the City of Mesquite does not adequately regulate the parking of boats and trailers upon the public streets creates an urgency and an emergency for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from its passage and publication as the law in such cases provides.
