

ORDINANCE NO. 2435

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 2352 BY REPLACING EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED TO AND MADE A PART OF ORDINANCE NO. 2352 WITH EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED HERETO, THEREBY CORRECTING THE LEGAL DESCRIPTIONS OF THE TRACTS ANNEXED THEREIN; BY PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; BY PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED (\$200.00) DOLLARS FOR EACH OFFENSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY:

WHEREAS, the legal description contained in Ordinance No. 2352 inadvertently contained some incorrect references;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 2352, adopted by the City Council on OCTOBER 20, 1986, is hereby amended by replacing Exhibit "A" attached thereto which incorrectly described the tracts annexed with Exhibit "A" attached hereto which correctly describes the tracts annexed. In all other respects said Ordinance No. 2352 to remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 2. That all ordinances, or portions thereof, of the City of Mesquite in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, to the extent of such conflict are hereby repealed. To the extent that such ordinances or portions thereof not in conflict herewith, the same shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That should any portion of the territory as described in Exhibit "A" not be subject to legal annexation by the City of Mesquite, such fact shall not prevent the City from annexation such territory which is subject to legal annexation by the City, and it is the intention of the City of Mesquite to annex only such territory as may be legally annexed by it within the limits of the area described in Exhibit "A".


SECTION 4. That any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be deemed to be guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor and subject to the same penalty as provided for in the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of 1973, of the City of Mesquite, and upon conviction in the Municipal Court shall be punished by a fine not to exceed Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars for each offense.

SECTION 5. The fact that the present ordinances of the City of Mesquite are inadequate to protect the health and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Mesquite creates an urgency and an emergency and necessitates that this ordinance become effective


immediately from and after its date of passage and the publication of its captions as the law in such cases provides.



COMMENCING at a point in the curving East right-of-way line of Big Town Boulevard (a 100' R.O.W.) said point also being the Northwest corner for the W.J. Farrell Addition as recorded in Volume 80139, Page 2009, Deed Records, Dallas County, Texas, said point also being situated on the corporate city limit line between the City of Dallas and the City of Mesquite:

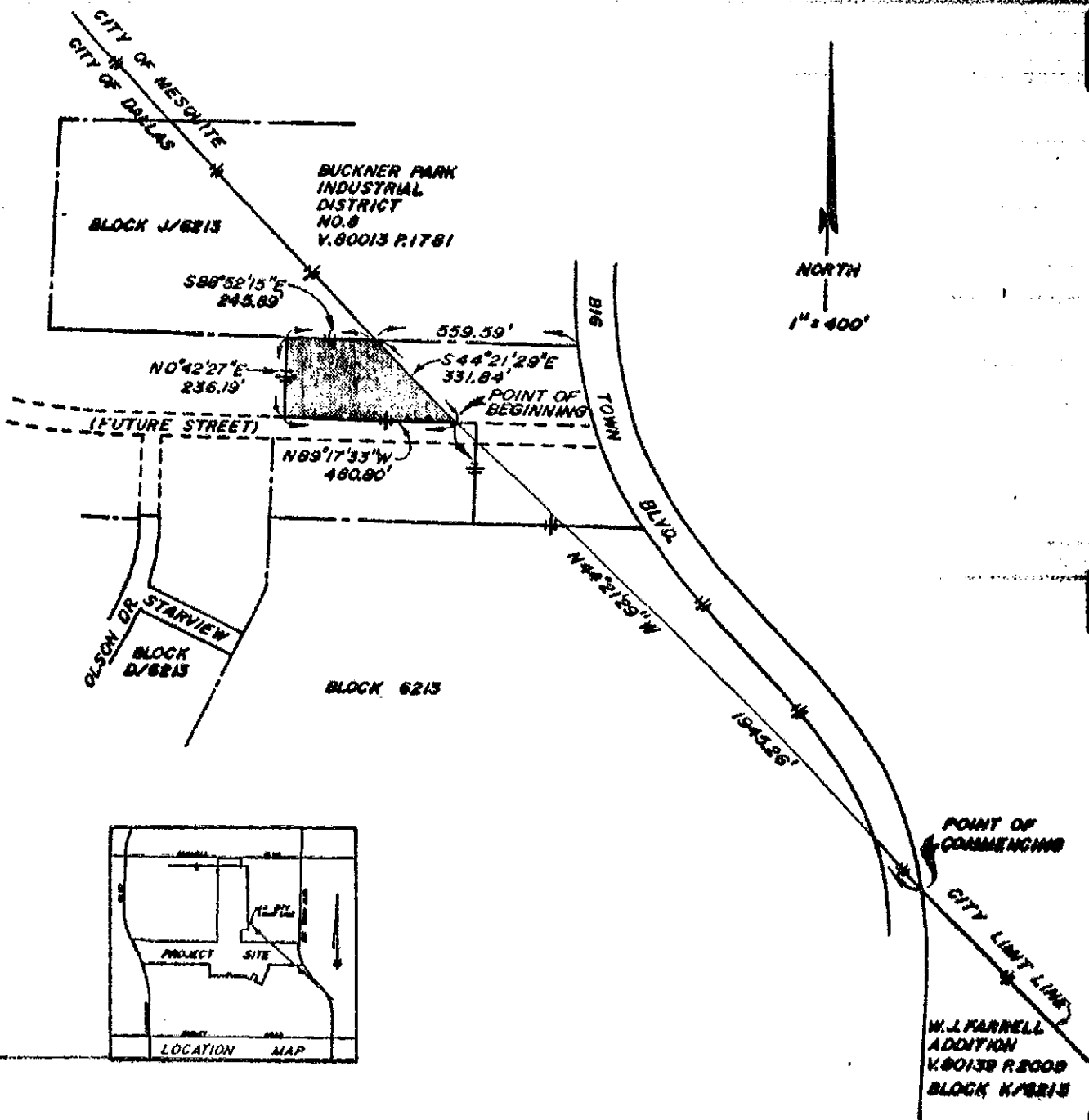
THENCE $N44^{\circ}21'29''W$ a distance of 1945.26 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING;

THENCE $N89^{\circ}17'33''W$ a distance of 480.80 feet to a point for corner;

THENCE $N0^{\circ}42'27''E$ a distance of 236.19 feet to a point for corner;

THENCE $S88^{\circ}52'15''E$ a distance of 245.89 feet to a point for corner, said point being located on the corporate city limit line between the City of Dallas and the City of Mesquite, said point also being $N88^{\circ}52'15''W$ a distance of 559.59 feet from the Southeast corner of Buckner Park Industrial District No. 8 as recorded in Volume 80013, Page 1781, Deed Records, Dallas County, Texas, said Southeast corner being located in the curving West right-of-way line of Big Town Boulevard (a 100' R.O.W.);

THENCE $S44^{\circ}21'29''E$ a distance of 331.84 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING and containing 85,381 square feet or 1.9600 acres of land, more or less.

BEING a tract of land situated in the Gideon Pemberton Survey, Abstract No. 1154, Dallas County, Texas, and being more particularly described as follows:

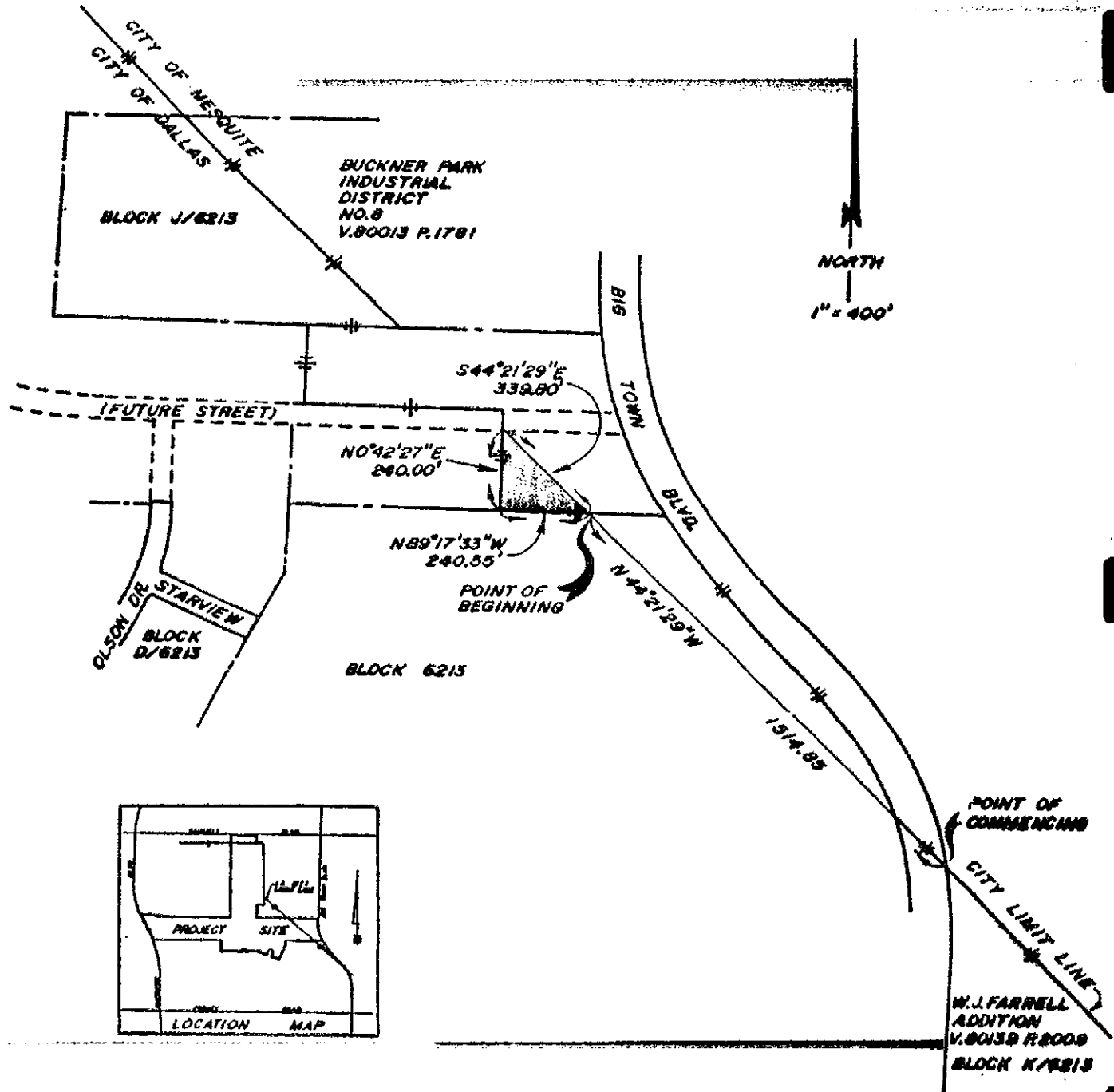
