ORDINANCE NO. 2436

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 2353 BY REPLACING EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED TO AND MADE A PART OF ORDINANCE NO. 2353 WITH EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED HERETO, THEREBY CORRECTING THE LEGAL DESCRIPTIONS OF THE TRACTS DEANNEXED THEREIN; BY PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; BY PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED (\$200.00) DOLLARS FOR EACH OFFENSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY:

WHEREAS, the legal description contained in Ordinance No. 2352 inadvertently contained some incorrect references;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 2353, adopted by the City Council on October 20, 1986, is hereby amended by replacing Exhibit "A" attached thereto which incorrectly described the tracts deannexed with Exhibit "A" attached hereto which correctly describes the tracts deannexed. In all other respects said Ordinance No. 2353 to remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 2. That all ordinances, or portions thereof, of the City of Mesquite in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, to the extent of such conflict are hereby repealed. To the extent that such ordinances or portions thereof not in conflict herewith, the same shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That should any portion of the territory as described in Exhibit "A" not be subject to legal annexation by the City of Mesquite, such fact shall not prevent the City from annexation such territory which is subject to legal annexation by the City, and it is the intention of the City of Mesquite to annex only such territory as may be legally annexed by it within the limits of the area described in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 4. That any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be deemed to be guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor and subject to the same penalty as provided for in the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of 1973, of the City of Mesquite, and upon conviction in the Municipal Court shall be punished by a fine not to exceed Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars for each offense.

SECTION 5. The fact that the present ordinances of the City of Mesquite are inadequate to protect the health and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Mesquite creates an urgency and an emergency and necessitates that this ordinance become effective




