ORDINANCE NO. 2440

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING SECTION 10-47.8, CHAPTER X OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE BY ESTABLISHING A SPEED LIMIT ALONG CERTAIN PORTIONS OF BARNES BRIDGE ROAD WITHIN THE CITY; BY PROVIDING THAT ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE ARE REPEALED TO THE EXTENT OF SUCH CONFLICT AND THAT SECTION 10-47.8, CHAPTER X, IN ALL OTHER RESPECTS, SHALL REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT; BY PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; BY PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00); AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, portions of Barnes Bridge Road are being reconstructed and therefore established herein are deemed necessary for the safety of the inhabitants of the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE:

SECTION 1. Chapter X, Section 10-47.8 of the Code of the City of Mesquite is hereby amended as follows; in all other respects to remain in full force and effect:

The following language shall be added to Chapter X, Section 10-47.8 of the Code of the City of Mesquite and the designated maximum speed limit on the stated portion of Barnes Bridge Road within the City is established as follows:

STREET

EXTENT

SPEED LIMIT

The same state of the same sta

Barnes Bridge Road

From N. Galloway Avenue to Belt Line Road

20 MPH

All other sections of Barnes Bridge Road shall remain as zoned.

SECTION 2. That any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be deemed to be guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor, and upon conviction in the Municipal Court shall be punished by a fine not to exceed Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars for each offense.

SECTION 3. That should any word, sentence, clause, paragraph or provision of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. Whereas, the tact that the ordinances of the City of Mesquite do not adequately regulate the speed of motor vehicles

along a portion of Barnes Bridge Road creates an urgency and emergency for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication of said ordinance, as the law in such cases provides.
