

ORDINANCE NO. 2496

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 20 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE BY DELETING CERTAIN PRESENT LANGUAGE AND ADDING CERTAIN NEW LANGUAGE; PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT AND REGULATION OF WRECKER SERVICE OPERATORS WITHIN THE CITY; PROVIDING A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED (\$200.00) DOLLARS; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT WITH THIS ORDINANCE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

**SECTION 1.** That Chapter 20 is hereby amended to read as follows, in all other respects to remain in full force and effect:

**Sec. 20-12. DISTRICTS.**

**Delete** the current paragraph No. 1 in its entirety and **substitute**, therefore, the following language:

(1) North Mesquite District - That area of the City north of a line beginning at the West City limits and the north boundary of the North Service Road of U.S. Highway 80 and extending along such boundary to the East City limits, including that portion of any intersecting streets within such area.

**Delete** the current paragraph No. 2 in its entirety and **substitute**, therefore, the following language:

(2) South Mesquite District - That area of the City south of the north boundary of the North Service Road of U.S. Highway 80 as it extends from the West City limits to the East City limits, including that portion of any intersecting streets within such area.

**Sec. 20-13. RATES.**

Amend the last sentence of the first paragraph by **substituting** "eight (\$8.00) dollars" for "five (\$5.00) dollars".

**Delete** the current final paragraph in its entirety and **substitute** the following:

A maximum of one (1) days storage charge for any vehicle redeemed within twelve (12) hours of impoundment shall be imposed. After that twelve-hour period, any portion of a day shall be considered a chargeable day.

**Sec. 20-16. AUTHORIZED OPERATORS DESIGNATED.**

In subsection (1), amend the date by **deleting** "January 1, 1987", through "December 31, 1987", by **substituting** "January 1, 1988, through December 31, 1988".

In subsection (2), amend the date by deleting "January 1, 1987, through December 31, 1987", by substituting "January 1, 1988, through December 31, 1988".

Sec. 20-18. RATES.

Delete the current third paragraph in its entirety and substitute a new third paragraph to read as follows:

A maximum of one (1) day's storage charge for any vehicle redeemed within twelve (12) hours of impoundment shall be imposed. After that twelve-hour period, any portion of a day shall be considered a chargeable day.

Sec. 20-21. AUTHORIZED OPERATOR DESIGNATED.

Amend the date by deleting January 1, 1987, through December 31, 1987 by substituting January 1, 1988, through December 31, 1988.

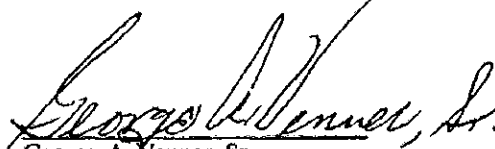
**SECTION 2.** Should any word, phrase, sentence, paragraph, or section of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions shall not be affected because of such invalidity or unconstitutionality.

**SECTION 3.** Any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed to be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction in the Municipal Court, shall be subject to a fine not to exceed two hundred (\$200.00) dollars for each offense.


**SECTION 4.** All ordinances or provisions thereof in conflict with this ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**SECTION 5.** The fact that the Code of the City of Mesquite is inadequate to afford wrecker service for the necessary protection of the inhabitants of the City creates an urgency and an emergency for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption of said ordinance, as the law in such cases provides.

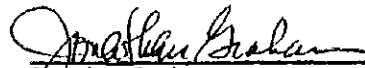
