ORDINANCE NO. 2505

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, PROVIDING FOR THE ABANDONMENT OF CERTAIN EASEMENTS SITUATED IN DALLAS COUNTY, TEXAS AND BEING A PORTION OF CREEK CROSSING ESTATES TRACT 20 AND TRACT 25 AS RECORDED IN VOLUME 85080, PAGE 1891 AND VOLUME 85080, PAGE 1939, DEED RECORDS OF DALLAS COUNTY, TEXAS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite has heretofore obtained public easements that are currently vacant and that will not be needed in the future.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City of Mesquite does hereby release and abandon the following easements located on Tract 20 and Tract 25 in Creek Crossing Estates described as follows:

- 15 foot Sanitary Sewer Basement Line "C"
 Recorded in Volume 85080, Page 1891, Deed Records of Dallas County, Texas and being more particularly described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto.
- 15 foot Sanitary Sewer Easement Line *D*
 Recorded in Volume 85080, Page 1891, Deed Records of Dallas County, Texas and being more particularly described in Exhibit *B* attached hereto.
- Outfall No. 7 Drainage Easement Recorded in Volume 85080, Page 1939, Deed Records of Dallas County, Texas and being more particularly described in Exhibit "C" attached hereto.
- 4. Outfall No. 3 West Drainage Easement
 Recorded in Volume 85080, Page 1939, Deed Records of Dallas County, Texas and
 being more particularly described in Exhibit "D" attached hereto.

SECTION 2. That said casements are not needed for public purposes and it is the public interest of the City of Mesquite to abandon said described easements and the same are hereby abandoned, vacated and closed insofar as the right, title or easement of the public is concerned.

SECTION 3. That the orderly development of the City of Mesquite requires the release and abandonment of the easements described herein, creates an urgency and emergency in the public interest and necessitates that this ordinance become effective immediately from and after its date of passage and the publication of the caption as the law in such cases provides.

FIELD NOTES 15' SANITARY SEWER EASEMENT LINE "C"

BEING a tract of land situated in the I. Edwards Survey, Abstract No. 445 and the J.P. Anderson Survey, Abstract No. 1, being part of a tract of land conveyed to Willard R. Baker as recorded in Volume 83196, Page 5343, Deed Records of Dallas County, Texas and being more particularly described as follows:

COMMENCING at an iron rod set at the intersection of the southwest line of Clay Mathis Road (100' R.O.W.) and the southeast line of Mercury Road (100' R.O.W.);

THENCE South 44°51'17" East along the said southwest line of Clay-Mathis Road a distance of 604.08 feet to an iron rod set for the beginning of a circular curve to the right having a central angle of 16°13'06", a radius of 2,300.00 feet; and a tangent length of 327.71 feet;




