

ORDINANCE NO. 2543

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, CHANGING THE NAMES OF PORTIONS OF CERTAIN STREETS WITHIN THE CITY, EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE AND APPROVAL OF THIS ORDINANCE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the following street names be changed as noted below, both such changes effective as of the date of passage and approval of this ordinance.


- a) The segment of the heretofore named Peachtree Road (old section) between Scyene Road and Peachtree Road (new section) is changed to Stadium Drive.
- b) The segment of the street heretofore named South Town East Boulevard between Military Parkway and Sam Houston Road is changed to Masters Drive.

SECTION 2. The fact that the street's name change is to be effective immediately upon passage and approval of this ordinance creates an urgency and an emergency and necessitates that this ordinance become effective immediately from and after its date of passage and the publication of its caption as the law in such cases provides.
