

ORDINANCE NO. 2562

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS ABOLISHING THE MESQUITE BEAUTIFICATION COMMISSION AS A CITY COMMISSION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 926 passed by the City Council on February 1, 1971, the Mesquite Environmental Improvement and Beautification Commission, presently known as Mesquite Beautification Commission was created; and


WHEREAS, it has been determined that the Mesquite Beautification Commission could operate more effectively for the benefit of the Citizens of Mesquite if it were to organize as a non-profit corporation and dissolve its identity as a City Commission;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the Mesquite Beautification Commission created by Ordinance No. 926 shall hereby be abolished and shall no longer operate or be identified as a City Commission.


SECTION 2. The fact that the interest of the citizens of the City of Mesquite will best be served by abolishing the Mesquite Beautification Commission creates an urgency and an emergency for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication of said ordinance, as the law in such cases provides.
