ORDINANCE NO. 2599

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2360 ADOPTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL ON NOVEMBER 17, 1986; BY ADDING FOUR (4) REGULAR MEMBERS TO THE MESQUITE HISTORICAL COMMISSION; PROVIDING AN EMERGENCY AND DECLARING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF SAID ORDINANCE.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 2360 adopted by the City Council on November 17, 1986, is hereby amended by adding four (4) regular members to be appointed by the City Council at large for a term of two (2) years except upon initial appointment the term of four (4) members shall be for one (1) year to provide for staggered terms, in all other respects said ordinance to remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 2. The fact that the existing Mesquite Historical Commission only has seven (7) regular members and two (2) alternate members creates an urgency and an emergency for the preservation of the public health, comfort and welfare of the citizens of Mesquite and requires that this ordinance shall take effect after passage of said ordinance, as the law in such cases provides.
