

ORDINANCE NO. 2627

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, DETERMINING THE POPULATION OF THE CITY AS OF OCTOBER 1, 1989, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


WHEREAS, by Charter Amendment, the City Council is required to determine the population as of the beginning of the fiscal year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. That the official population of the City as of October 1, 1989, is hereby determined to be 103,550.

SECTION 2. The fact that no regular scheduled Council meeting will take place prior to October 1, 1989, and the City Charter requires the population to be determined as of that date creates an urgency and emergency and requires this ordinance take effect immediately as the law in such cases provides.


