

ORDINANCE NO. 2641

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, CHANGING THE NAMES OF PORTIONS OF CERTAIN STREETS AND NAMING A NEW CONNECTING STREET WITHIN THE CITY, EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE AND APPROVAL OF THIS ORDINANCE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the following street names be changed as noted below and naming a new connecting street, such changes effective as of the date of passage and approval of this ordinance.

- a) The segment of the heretofore named Lawson Road (old section) from the Dallas City Limits to Lawson Road (new section) is changed to Old Lawson Road.
- b) The segment of the heretofore named Chapplewood Boulevard from the Dallas City Limits to McKenzie Road is changed to Lawson Road.
- c) The segment of the heretofore unnamed, newly constructed roadway, commonly called Lawson Road (new section) from McKenzie Road to Lawson Road (old section) is designated Lawson Road.

SECTION 2. The fact that the current street names are confusing and thereby constitute a safety hazard for motorists and a problem for emergency response creates an urgency and an emergency and necessitates that this ordinance become effective immediately from and after its date of passage and the publication of its caption as the law in such cases provides.
