

ORDINANCE NO. 2682AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, REPEALING  
ORDINANCE NOS. 1220, 1584, AND 2079; PROVIDING FOR A  
SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite, by and through Ordinance Nos. 1220, 1584, and 2079 adopted provisions to pay firefighters for work out of classification, in good faith, to comply with requirements of the State Civil Service statute regarding out of class pay; and

WHEREAS, subsequent interpretations of the State statute have made it necessary for changes in the policies regarding pay for work out of classification, which have resulted in the need to repeal Ordinance Nos. 1220, 1584, and 2079.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That City of Mesquite Ordinance Nos. 1220, 1584, and 2079 are hereby repealed in their entirety.


SECTION 2. That should any word, sentence, clause, paragraph, or provision of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining portions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. The fact that the present ordinances of the City of Mesquite do not adequately protect the public interest, comfort, and welfare of the City of Mesquite, creates an urgency and emergency for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage as the law in such cases provides.


