

## ORDINANCE NO. 2695

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 6B OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, RELATING TO ELECTIONS; PROVIDING AN EMERGENCY AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 6B of the Code of the City of Mesquite is hereby amended as follows in all other respects to remain in full force and effect:


A. That a new Section 6B.7, Write-in Candidates, is hereby adopted to read as follows:

**Sec. 6B-7. Write-in Candidates.**

Write-in candidates for municipal offices are required to declare their candidacies thirty (30) days prior to election day.

SECTION 2. The fact that the present ordinances of the City of Mesquite are inadequate to protect the health and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Mesquite, creates an urgency and an emergency and necessitates that this ordinance become effective immediately from and after its date of passage and the publication of its caption as the law in such cases provides.
