

ORDINANCE NO. 2721

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1136, MESQUITE SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS BY DELETING REFERENCES TO ARTICLE 974a OF VERNON'S TEXAS REVISED CIVIL STATUTES CONTAINED THEREIN AND REPLACING SUCH REFERENCES WITH V.T.C.A. LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, SECTION 212.001 ET SEQ.; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the Subdivision Ordinance of the City of Mesquite is hereby amended by deleting all references to Article 974a of Vernon's Texas Revised Civil Statutes and replacing such references with V.T.C.A. Local Government Code, Section 212.001 et seq.


SECTION 2. That should any word, sentence, clause, paragraph, or provision of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. The fact that the present ordinances of the City of Mesquite are inadequate to protect the public interest, comfort, and general welfare of the City of Mesquite, creates an urgency and an emergency for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication of said ordinance, as the law in such cases provides.


