

ORDINANCE NO. 2786


AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2767 AND REINSTATING ORDINANCE NO. 2701 CONTAINING THE SANITATION RATES; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. That the Sanitation Rate Ordinance previously adopted by the City Council by Ordinance No. 2767, on September 16, 1991, is hereby repealed, and Ordinance No. 2701, adopted September 17, 1990 is hereby reinstated in its entirety as set out in the attached Exhibit "A".


SECTION 2. The fact that the sanitation collection rates prior to September 16, 1991 of the City of Mesquite were adequate creates an urgency and an emergency for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and requires that this ordinance restoring the rate structure that existed prior to September 16, 1991, shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication of said ordinance, as the law in such cases provides.
