AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING SECTION 9-150 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE BY DELETING CERTAIN PRESENT

LANGUAGE AND ADDING CERTAIN LANGUAGE THEREBY CHANGING CERTAIN SPEED ZONE LOCATIONS; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 9-150 of the Code of the City of Mesquite is hereby amended as follows, in all other respects to remain in full force and effect:

The following language shall be deleted from Section 9-150 of the Code of the City of Mesquite:

STREET

EXTENT

SPEED (MPH)

**Bruton Road** 

From west city limit to Interstate

40

Highway 635

The following language shall be added to Section 9-150 of the Code of the City of Mesquite:

STREET

EXTENT

SPEED (MPH)

Bruton Road

From west city limit to Interstate

35

Highway 635

<u>SECTION 2</u>. That should any paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase section or provision of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part o provision hereof other than the part so decided to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid and shall not affect the validity of the remainder of Section 9-150, or any other provision of the Code of the City of Mesquite.

SECTION 3. That any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provision or terms of this ordinance shall be deemed to be guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor an upon conviction in the Municipal Court shall be punished by a fine not to exceed Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars for each offense.

SECTION 4. The fact that the present ordinances of the City of Mesquite do no adequately protect the safety of the inhabitants of the City, creates an urgency and
