WHEREAS, the City of Mesquite has heretofore obtained utility, fire lane and a easements that will not be needed in the future: NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE OF MESQUITE, TEXAS: That a portion of Crest Addition, more particularly describ Exhibit "A" attached hereto and included herein for all purposes shall be, and the se hereby abandoned. SECTION 2. That said utility, fire lane and access easements are not need public purposes and it is the public interest of the City of Mesquite to abandor described easements and the same is hereby abandoned, vacated and closed insofar right, title or easements of the public are concerned. That the orderly development of the City of Mesquite require release and abandonment of the easements described herein, creates an urgenc emergency in the public interest and necessitates that this ordinance become eff immediately from and after its date of passage and the publication of the caption as tl in such cases provides.
