

ORDINANCE NO. 2838

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING THE CITY OF MESQUITE CLASSIFICATION AND PAY PLAN BY ABOLISHING THREE (3) POLICE OFFICER POSITIONS AND CREATING THREE (3) POLICE SERGEANT POSITIONS; AND PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City of Mesquite Classification and Pay Plan is hereby amended as follows, in all other respects to remain in full force and effect:

A. The number of police officer positions heretofore authorized is hereby reduced by three (3) and the said three (3) positions are hereby abolished;


B. The number of police sergeant positions heretofore authorized is hereby increased by three (3) and said three (3) positions are hereby created.

SECTION 2. That section 1 of this Ordinance shall become effective July 1, 1993.

SECTION 3. That should any word, sentence, clause, paragraph or provision of this ordinance to be held to be invalid or unconstitutional the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.


SECTION 4. The fact that the present composition of the Police Department is inadequate to protect the health and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Mesquite creates an urgency and emergency and necessitates that this ordinance become effective immediately from and after its date of passage and the publication of its caption as the law in such cases provides.


