

ORDINANCE NO. 2852

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING THE CITY OF MESQUITE CLASSIFICATION AND PAY PLAN BY ABOLISHING POSITIONS OF COMMUNICATIONS OPERATOR AND LEAD COMMUNICATIONS OPERATOR AND CREATING POSITIONS OF COMMUNICATIONS OPERATOR I, II, AND III; ALLOWING TEN (\$10.00) DOLLARS PER DAY FOR TRAINING ASSIGNMENTS AND UP TO 10% ADDITIONAL FOR SHIFT COORDINATION; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. That the City of Mesquite Classification and Pay Plan is hereby amended as follows, in all other respects to remain in full force and effect:

- A. The positions of Communications Operator and Lead Communications Operator heretofore authorized are hereby abolished;
- B. The positions of Communications Operator I, Communications Operator II, and Communications Operator III are hereby created; and
- C. A rate of \$10.00 per day for training assignments and up to 10% additional for shift coordination.

SECTION 2. That should any word, sentence, clause, paragraph or provision of this ordinance be held to be invalid or unconstitutional the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.


SECTION 3. The fact that the Classification and Pay Plan of the City of Mesquite is inadequate to provide stability and continuity in the employment of essential employees, creates an urgency and an emergency and necessitates that this ordinance become effective immediately from and after its date of passage and the publication of its caption as the law in such cases provides.


