

ORDINANCE NO. 2889

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS, AMENDING SECTION 9-147 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE; BY MODIFYING THE BOUNDARIES FOR EXISTING SCHOOL ZONES; PROVIDING THE LOCATION AND TIME OF SAID SCHOOL ZONES AND MAINTAINING THE MAXIMUM PRIMA FACIE SPEED LIMIT DURING SUCH PERIOD TO BE TWENTY (20) MILES PER HOUR; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED (\$200.00) DOLLARS FOR EACH OFFENSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 9-147 subsections (1) and (2) of the Code of the City of Mesquite are hereby amended as follows, in all other respects to remain in full force and effect:

- (1) The following streets and portions thereof are hereby designated as school zones for the school indicated from 7:00 A.M. to 8:15 A.M. and from 2:30 P.M. to 3:30 P.M. and said streets and portions thereof are hereby zoned for a maximum speed of twenty (20) miles per hour during such times. Any speed in excess of said maximum shall be prima facie unreasonable and imprudent:

The following language shall be deleted from Section 9-147 subsection (1) of the Code of the City of Mesquite:

Black	Bryan-Belt Line Road from Norwood Drive to 50 feet north of Newsom Road

The following language shall be added to Section 9-147 subsection (1) of the Code of the City of Mesquite:

Motley	Moon Drive from 50 feet east of Hyde Park Drive to Motley Drive
Porter	Via Avenida from Via Del Norte to Via Ventura
Shands	Shands Drive from Karla Drive to Caribbean Drive Karla Drive from Stallcup Drive to Preston Trial Galloway Avenue from 250 feet south of Karla Drive to 250 feet north of Karla Drive LaPrada Drive from Ivy Drive to 300 feet west of Sandra Lynn Drive
Tosch	Gus Thomasson Road from 200 feet north of Motley Drive to 50 feet south of the U.S. 80 north frontage road access ramp Rustown Drive from 50 feet north of Larchmont Drive to Apollo Way Baker Drive from Greenhill Drive to Northview Drive

- (2) The following streets and portions thereof are hereby designated as school zones for the school indicated from 7:45 A.M. to 8:45 A.M. and from 2:30 P.M. to 4:00 P.M. and said streets and portions thereof are hereby zoned for a maximum speed of twenty (20) miles per hour during such times. Any speed in excess of said maximum shall be prima facie unreasonable and imprudent:

The following language shall be ~~deleted~~ from Section 9-147 subsection (2) of the Code of the City of Mesquite:

Shands	Shands Drive from Karla Drive to Caribbean Drive Karla Drive from Stallcup Drive to Preston Trail Galloway Avenue from 250 feet south of Karla Drive to 250 feet north of Karla Drive LaPrada Drive from Ivy Drive to 300 feet west of Sandra Lynn Drive

The following language shall be ~~added~~ to Section 9-147 subsection (2) of the Code of the City of Mesquite:


<u>SCHOOL</u>	<u>LOCATION OF SCHOOL ZONE</u>
Agnew	Agnew Street from Wilkinson Drive to Carver Street
Kimbrough	Galloway Avenue from Devonshire Lane to 1000 feet north of Devonshire Lane

SECTION 2. That should any paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase, section or provision of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part so decided to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid and shall not affect the validity of the remainder of Section 9-147, or any other provision of the Code of the City of Mesquite.

SECTION 3. That any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be deemed to be guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor and upon conviction in the Municipal Court shall be punished by a fine not to exceed Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars for each offense.




