

ORDINANCE NO. 2898

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS,
ADOPTING THE CHANGES MADE TO SEALED
BIDDING AND COMPETITIVE SEALED PROPOSAL
REQUIREMENTS BY THE 1993 STATE LEGISLATURE
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


WHEREAS, Local Government Code, Section 252.021 has been amended to increase the amount by which a municipality may expend without compliance with the bid requirements thereof from Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) to Fifteen Thousand (\$15,000.00) Dollars; and whereas other changes have been made to the Local Government Code Chapter 252;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MESQUITE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City of Mesquite hereby adopts all applicable changes made to the Local Government Code Chapter 252 by the 1993 State Legislature.

SECTION 2. The fact that these changes are necessary for the immediate health and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Mesquite, creates an urgency and an emergency for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication of said ordinance, as the law in such cases provides.
